Eurasia Foundation of Central Asia</p>	<p>“Zharkyra” Social Entrepreneurship Development Program</p>	<p>Objective: to support innovative social initiatives aimed at providing sustainable entrepreneurial solutions to social, economic and environmental problems of the public of the city of Atyrau and the oblast. Goal 1: Provide opportunities for the public to find innovative solutions to socio-economic problems through a public awareness campaign on social entrepreneurship. Goal 2: to provide educational, financial and consulting support to aspiring social entrepreneurs in the implementation of new initiatives aimed at solving social problems of the society.</p>	<p>The results of the competition "Zharkyra" 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introductory seminars on social entrepreneurship were held in all 7 districts of the region and covered 561 residents of the region. • 112 applications were submitted to the competition, most of which were received from Atyrau and Zhylyoy district (68). • According to the legal form, the participants of the competition were divided as follows: individuals - 48, legal entities and businesses (IE and LLP) - 46, NGOs – 18. • 13,784 residents of the region learned about the contest through social networks. • According to the results of the voting of the expert committee consisting of 5 people, 30 semi-finalists were selected for further training, who were trained in business skills in four areas: marketing, finance, strategic planning and public speaking. • 6 finalists from Atyrau and 1 from Makhambet district received 5 loans and 2 grants in the amount of 17,860,000 tenge, of which 11,860,000 tenge were returned loans <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Project areas: folk crafts, medicine, kindergarten services and sports for children with cerebral palsy, rehabilitation and employment of former convicts, and child development. • 6 SEs in 2020 have undergone training and had an exchange of experience. They remotely participated in internships in Almaty, Nur-Sultan and Moscow, Tyumen. As a result of the internships, SEs acquired new partnerships, suppliers, equipment, and learned new working methods. • Project «Kazakh Kyzy Academy» by Asiya Muhsinova replaced getting the internship to a franchise. Thus, for the first time, in the framework of the project, a local social business got a franchise. <p><i>General information about the program</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 organizations out of 38 stopped working and 5 social entrepreneurs stopped paying the loan due to the quarantine. • Active social entrepreneurs reported an average turnover increase of 48 percent. • Five social entrepreneurs attracted additional funding for their projects. • A total of 32 persons are employed on a permanent or temporary basis in the supported social entrepreneurs. • According to the results of the year, SE 2020 opened 3 new services for the population. • The total coverage of the population in the oblast was 525 persons, 83 of whom are from socially vulnerable groups of the population. • Representatives of EFCA, Temirbekov Rinad and Tagatova Aigul, took part in the work of the group of experts attached to the Senate of the Republic of Kazakhstan on drafting the law on social entrepreneurship of the Republic of Kazakhstan. EFCA made its recommendations based on the practical experience of the Zharkyra program. <p><i>Challenges encountered and lessons learned</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – EFCA made an analysis of the problems of SE during the quarantine and based on it organized diagnostics of businesses and SMM support. – During the quarantine medical SEs did not stop working and received state orders, thus were able to increase their turnovers. – Since many SEs provide services to children and locals, because of the restrictions they were unable to fully operate during the quarantine. – The lack of communication due to quarantine was acutely felt, also SE 2020 could not sufficiently integrate into the Zharkyra community. – Due to quarantine, many SE were forced to change places for internships from Russia to Kazakhstan.

The level of knowledge increased from 57% to 92% and 42% to 92% among non-health and health workers, respectively. - To assess the level of knowledge, 59 nurses from 39 schools in Atyrau were interviewed for knowledge about tuberculosis prevention measures, filling out the relevant documentation and other organizational issues for the diagnosis of latent tuberculosis infection (hereinafter referred to as LTBI). The general level of knowledge of the survey participants was 83%. To further improve the quality of knowledge on tuberculosis among nurses of school institutions, it is necessary to continue conducting training seminars. In addition, information material for education and use in the workplace was prepared for school nurses. - 14,079 students, pregnant women and contact persons were covered by information sessions; - more than 21,700 copies of information materials were transferred to polyclinics and mosques in Atyrau and Zhylyoi district, and distributed among the target groups; - For the first time in the National TB Program (NTP), an operational research project was conducted to study the effectiveness of measures to control TB and MDR-TB among children and adolescents. It is planned that the results and recommendations of the operational research will be used not only in the Atyrau region, but also in the entire national anti-tuberculosis service in order to improve the health of children and adolescents; - 90 publications in social networks and mass media. <p>According to Atyrau Oblast TB Dispensary, there are following indirect results:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in Atyrau, it was possible to cover with BCG vaccinations an additional 1,062 children discharged from maternity hospitals without BCG vaccination, of which 146 due to parental refusal; - in the Zhylyoi district, it was possible to cover with BCG vaccinations an additional 105 children discharged from maternity hospitals without BCG vaccination, of which 3 due to parental refusal. - a decrease in the incidence of tuberculosis among children under 18 years of age in Atyrau from 33 cases in 2019 to 19 cases in 2020 in absolute numbers, or a decrease by 43% compared to 2019; - a decrease in the incidence of tuberculosis among children under 18 years old in the Zhylyoi district from 7 cases in 2019 to 6 cases in 2020 in absolute numbers, or by 15% decrease compared to 2019; <p>Difficulties encountered</p> <p>In connection with the pandemic COVID-19 and the quarantine it should be noted the following difficulties in project implementation: (1) cases of infection of patients COVID-19 among the project staff; (2) lack of access to children and teenagers to educate them in educational institutions; (3) lack of access to education staff, clinics and maternity homes led to the postponement of planned workshops at a later date; (4) the heads of departments and agencies of Atyrau region, participating in the activities of the project were very busy fighting with the coronavirus; (5) the training of instructors was not carried out due to the quarantine, as online training on this topic is ineffective.</p>

Participants: children from 10 to 18 years old; parents; teachers and psychologists</p>	<p>Total number of beneficiaries - 1744</p> <p>The results in the directions</p> <p><i>Psychologists:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They studied the primary course on SMM management, learned how to make publications about their work. • Work on the modules of the Skillfolio block on flexible skills (communication and adaptation skills) takes place in two groups of psychologists, online, Atyrau, and Kulsary, a total of 17 people. • At the first stage of acquaintance with art therapy, they worked with the "Fractal Drawing" method, themselves, and then with teams of willing teachers. A group of children with access to the Internet also joined this work. • The works of students were collected and submitted to a photo contest about the nature of the Atyrau oblast. • Explanatory consultations for school graduates were conducted on choosing a profession, using workbooks and methods used by us on the project. • They have added psychological techniques to their portfolio and are preparing for the autumn competition among schools. <p><i>Students:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students in grades 9 and 11 received advice on their choice of profession.

Work in summer and school camps is not possible at all, so the club work is stopped completely. • Very quickly, we had to change the approaches to working with children, and the requirements for their capabilities, including technical ones, changed.

Respiratory gymnastics in the rehabilitation of patients after pneumonia". • In addition to their special and coaching skills, the specialists of "BolashakK" have learned and successfully mastered the skills of conducting trainings and practical classes online. They have mastered the skills of public speaking, learned to speak in public, to hold an audience.

This result can be traced through quantitative indicators of the increase in the number of users and beneficiaries on the counters of the fund's website and the K@Z@KSH@ S@YR@! group on Facebook, the number of views and reactions to the project's video products in the YouTube service. In 2020 – 324 160 users (compared to 2019 – 69 443) - Production of unique e-books (http://kabdolov.kz/aqa-sha-sayra/literatura-lektronnye-knigi). This direction of the project is an innovative way to achieve the goals of the project. Its uniqueness is that in 2013, for the first time in Kazakhstan, within the framework of this program "K@Z@KSH@ S@YR@" (PSI TCO), the first bilingual e-book "Ainalayin, Atyrau" was published. The innovation is that on the same page of the book, identical texts in 2 languages are given in vocabulary, which makes it easier to read and learn another language at the same time without having to rummage through dictionaries or look for a translation in other places of the work. The books are compatible with the iPad and Android platforms, which makes them available to users of almost all types of electronic literature readers. The authors of these books are mainly members of the Kabdolov Foundation and the Alshy Foundation, and additionally other local authors. To date, about a dozen of these books have been produced, and the 2020 project has added 4 additional works to this library. <p>The following activities were carried out within the framework of the project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • writing and translating e-books, • shooting podcasts for further editing them, • project publications on the foundation's website and their further promotion on social networks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ a total of 497 project publications were made, of which: a) 113 were published on the foundation's website and are both the project's products and the creative works of the



			<p>project performers and their partners; b) 278 materials found their place in the FB group "K@Z@KSH@ S@YR@"; c) 106 publications - on various sites, portals, groups.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the same time, new project headings were opened and updated with educational materials, and materials were updated in the existing project headings. • The site counter recorded that over the past six months, 3,197 visitors from 38 countries of the world became users of the project. <p>The project has creative partners in the person of the Literary and Historical Cultural Foundation "Alshy", the animation studio "ANIMA BOOK", as well as individual creative personalities: the famous writer and poet Raikhan Aldabergenova from Kazakhstan; the famous director and screenwriter Azhdar Hajiyev in Kazakhstan and Azerbaijan; the talented artist, designer and book graphic artist from Azerbaijan Maria Kel.</p> <p>Since this project was originally online, COVID-19, the project performers did not experience.
