## Minutes of

Consultation Meeting on the Future Growth Project –

Wellhead Pressure Management Project, Tengizchevroil LLP

Venue:	Maikumgen village, Zhylyoi region, Atyrau Oblast

**N. Sauytov, Maikumgen District Akim,** opened the meeting, welcomed the residents and informed that Tengizchevroil LLP (TCO) will provide an overview on the Future Growth Project-Wellhead Pressure Management Project (FGP-WPMP). Further on the floor was given to Mr. R. Artygaliev.

**R. Artygaliev (TCO)** greeted the village residents. He announced that the consultation meeting's purpose – to provide an update on TCO FGP-WPMP Project, hear out residents' views on TCO and the Project. He further emphasized that this meeting is not a public hearing. It has been told that Project presentations will be made first, and then Q&A session will start and if the participants wish to ask questions in written they can use special forms, which will be handed out to all attendees. TCO contact details can be found in handouts, which have been provided to the audience for further clarifications on any issues. Next, R. Artygaliev introduced to the audience Galiya Esenova, Community Liaison Officer for Zhylyoi region and briefed on her responsibilities – to ensure regular liaison with local community.

Next, according to the agenda, Nurtas Kenganov, FGP-WPMP Regulatory Affairs Manager provided presentation on TCO and FGP-WPMP.

Following the presentation, R. Artygaliev highlighted two focus areas. First – the successful cooperation between TCO and the RoK Ministry of Labour and Social Protection of Population resulted in the decision to make all the TCO FGP-WPMP contractors and subcontractors use ENBEK.kz, a unified web portal, to post available vacancies and select personnel. Registration in the web-portal is free. All RoK citizens would be able to access the vacancies database. Owner of the unified digital Labour Employment Service ENBEK.kz was the Ministry of Labour and Social Protection of the Population. To date over 4,000 vacancies have been posted on this web-portal. R. Artygaliev encouraged all attendees to sign up in web-portal. At peak construction, it is expected to create 20,000 jobs in Kazakhstan. Given that the work is on a rotational basis, about 30,000 – 35,000 people will be engaged on the Project. Over 20,000 Kazakhstani Nationals are working in the Project (Onshore), which makes up 92% of the overall number of Kazakhstani employees.

Further, R. Artygaliev informed that 4 major contracts are planned to be awarded late this year and by early next year, which means the beginning of major construction activities in Tengiz and thus indicates a need for new workforce.

Second – the Cargo Offloading Facility is being constructed at Prorva, and the Project is experiencing difficulties related to the unauthorized access by local people to facility construction area for fishing. The Akim of Atyrau Oblast was informed about the situation, and the measures are now underway. The people's access to construction area will be limited since this impedes the implementation of construction works at Cargo Offloading Facility site. R. Artygaliev asked the local people to take the given information into account.

Next, R. Artygaliev provided action plan's details following the previous meeting. It has been mentioned that questions and comments raised by the participants were addressed after the meeting. R. Artygaliev highlighted that four residents of Maikumgen village addressed to us via feedback forms regarding the delay in construction of kindergarten and health and sports center. He advised the participants that this issue is being addressed in a collaborative way with the Akimat of Atyrau oblast and the intention is to complete these projects in 2018. The decision will be made within a month.

Next, Q&A session has started.

**K. Agayev:** I was going to ask you about construction of kindergarten, school and sports center. You have already answered my questions.

**N. Sauytov (Maikumgen District Akimat):** The critical area of concern for us was around the construction of kindergarten and sports center. Another issue is that young people are leaving the village due to the unemployment problems. If previously mentioned facilities are constructed, about 40-50 people will be provided with jobs. We expect that kindergarten and sports center will be constructed in 2018. In addition to that, Akimat intends to construct school for 320 seats next year. The funds will be allocated from the regional budget.

Question: Thank you for the information provided. Please come and visit us every year.

**R. Artygaliev (TCO):** Consultation meetings will be held annually and we are going to provide you with updates on FGP-WPMP progress.

N. Sauytov thanked TCO for organizing this meeting and thanked all the residents who participated in it.
